Chino's identity is inseparable from the sky above it. In 1940, the Cal-Aero Academy opened at what is now Chino Airport as the first civilian aviation school in the United States ... and quickly became the model for 62 other flight schools built across the country. When World War II arrived, the Army Air Force leased the facility and transformed it into one of the most productive military pilot training installations in the nation. Over the course of the war, more than 12,000 cadets learned to fly here, graduating every six weeks and deploying directly into combat theaters across the Pacific and Europe. They flew Stearmans, BT-13s, and T-6s over the skies of Chino before carrying American freedom into the most consequential conflict of the 20th century.

A commons, in the American tradition, is a shared space where community gathers ... rooted in the colonial era town greens that predate the founding of the nation itself. In 2026, as the United States celebrates 250 years of independence, naming this park Cadet Commons draws a direct line from those founding ideals to the generation that defended them over Chino's airfields. The name honors every cadet who soloed here, graduated here, and went on to serve. It belongs to the community as much as it belonged to them.

Cadet Commons is not a memorial. It is a living tribute ... a place where Chino residents gather, play, and breathe the same air those cadets once flew through.







Russ Miller dedicated his life to serving others. He proudly served his country for six years in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War. He later answered the call to serve the Chino community, joining the Chino Police Department on February 5, 1988, and faithfully serving the residents of Chino for more than 12 years.

Beyond his public service, Russ was deeply involved in youth sports and was a strong advocate for children and families. He coached Little League baseball and dedicated his time to mentoring young people through sports and other community activities. Those who knew him remember him as a man with a big heart who cared deeply about children, families, and serving others. Through his commitment to teamwork, sportsmanship, and serving as a positive role model, he helped improve the quality of life for countless young people and families. More than 26 years after his death, his impact continues to be remembered through the annual Run for Russ event, which honors his life, service, and sacrifice.

On February 1, 2000, Officer Miller was killed in the line of duty while protecting the community he loved. The proposed park's focus on recreation, wellness, family activities, walking paths, gardens, games, and gathering spaces reflects the very values Russ championed throughout his life.

Naming this park Russell M. Miller Sr. Memorial Park would recognize his military service, dedication to the City of Chino, ultimate sacrifice, and lasting legacy as a public servant, youth mentor, veteran, and community champion.
