WHEREAS, the City of Chino has been recognized for over 31 years as a "Tree City USA" by the National Arbor Day Foundation; and

WHEREAS, trees in our City increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community; and

WHEREAS, trees can reduce wind and water erosion, cut heating and cooling costs, clean the air, produce life-giving oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource - giving us paper, wood for our homes, and fuel for our fires, and countless other wood products; and

WHEREAS, through the cooperation of the residents of the City of Chino and community groups, the benefits of planting trees and proper conservation practices can be passed on in an enduring heritage of vital natural resources to the citizens of Chino.

ARBOR DAY


