1. Update on Federal Issues. Receive a report on federal legislative and budget issues. Receive and file.

Council Member Comstock spoke in opposition to SB 274 and reported that the Cal Cities board members have expressed the need of unilateral support for bills that support public safety.

The Committee Members inquired about Assembly Bill (AB) 495 and asked Chief Mensen to provide follow-up information when possible.

Vivian Castro, Deputy City Manager, provided an update.

Mr. Gonsalves and Chief Mensen provided information on the City of Norco State prison closure.
