

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-XXX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHINO, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT A COMPREHENSIVE UPDATE TO TITLE 16 (SIGNS) OF THE CHINO MUNICIPAL SIGN CODE TO AMEND AND REORGANIZE MULTIPLE CHAPTERS OF TITLE 16; PL26-0057 (ZONE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT).

The City Council of the City of Chino, California, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title 16 (Signs) of the Chino Municipal Code is hereby revised as identified in "Exhibit A" to this document.

Section 2. The City Council finds that this Ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), Common Sense Exemption, in that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility for this action to have a significant effect on the environment, and individual development applications will be reviewed under CEQA as they are proposed.

Section 3. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any other provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, part or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, parts or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its second reading and adoption.

Section 5. Certification. The City Clerk of the City of Chino shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance (Ordinance No. 2026-XXX) and shall cause the same to be published in the *Chino Champion*, a newspaper of general circulation, within said City in accordance with the provisions of the Government Code.
